Programs of study (specialties)

n Nicolae Testemitanu SUMPh there are following undergraduate programs of study: Medicine, Public Health, Optometry, Nursing, Dentistry and Pharmacy. Foreign citizens may apply for Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy programs in Romanian, English, French or Rus-

sian languages of training. All of the students learn compulsory Romanian language. Before joining to undergraduate course, foreign students can opt for a preparatory course, which include basics of biology, chemistry and physics in Romanian or English language.

University provides postgraduate programs and also Master or PhD training for advanced scientific education in the fields of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy in diverse specialties in Romanian language.

At the University the study process includes modern training approaches like theoretical courses, practical activities, clinical training in hospitals, problem-based learning, case -based learning, simulation activities,

computer training, role-playing, elements of distance learning teaching and individual activities. Students

are taught in small groups by using up-to-date equipment, intensive and interactive teaching. Our students are learned to think critically, analytically and solve problems. We consider team working and training in the field of communication with the patients very important.

The academic year lasts 34 weeks (5 working days each), divided into two

equal semesters and two examination sessions.

Program of study Medicine

Program of study Medicine is performed at two faculties: Medicine no. 1 (languages of training Romanian, Russian and French) and Medicine no. 2 (language of training English). The duration of studies is 6 years. Students start their studies mainly with pre-clinical subjects in the first II years. Clinical disciplines are included gradually and are carried out at the University Chairs (Departments) based in hospitals, where students develop their communication and practical skills.

The curriculum meets the recommendations of the WHO and Association of Medical Schools in Europe concerning the medical education. In 2018 the Medicine study program was accredited by National Accreditation Board and in 2019 was accredited according to the World Federation of Medical Education (WFME) requirements.

There are more than 4000 students at the program of study Medicine (including 2000 international students). International students have optimal conditions for studying medicine (simulation center, well equipped laboratories, up-to-date information resources, and access to the patients).

After graduation, international students usually have to pass a screening test in the country of origin.









Program of study Dentistry

he students of the program of study Dentistry are trained at the Faculty of Dentistry, and have their clinical practice at different clinical setting, including two university dental clinics, equipped with modern devices and medical manikins that are used to help

The duration of studies is 5 years. Clinical training starts

Program of study Pharmacy

The students of the Pharmacy program of study are trained at the Faculty of Pharmacy, furnished with modern equipment that meets all the requirements for training. The practical skills are developed at the Pharmaceutical Center, drug stores (including University Pharmacy) and the Scientific Center of Medicinal Herbs Cultivation.

The duration of studies is 5 years. There are near 400 students at the program of study Pharmacy. The meets the standards curriculum and is based on the requirements of the European Directives in the field of pharmaceutrtical education. In 2018 the Pharmacy study program was accredited by National Accreditation Board.



5 Scientific Medical Library

ur University has a modern and well-stocked Scientific Medical Library that offers support for the educational and scientific processes and provides a range of information services for beneficiaries.

The Library offers access to more than 900 000 publications (in Romanian, English, Russian, French and

other languages) in the lecture halls and for home loans (textbooks and scientific publications). The Library provides online access to the programs: HINARI, OARE, ARDI and various medical databases like Scopus, Cochrane Library, Cambridge Journal Online, STAT!Ref, OncologySTAT, etc. and offline access to a representative collection of CDs and DVDs.

Open 7 days a week, the University Library has 5 reading rooms and 4 information centers equipped with computers and Internet connection, located in different regions of the city (near the campus and hospitals).

he University Center for Simulation in Medical Training (UCSMT) of *Nicolae Testemitanu* SUMPh is one of the most advanced centers in Eastern Europe, accord-

Here are provided courses for students and medical specialists at all levels of continuing training, where you can get: communication skills with patients, the basic practical medical and surgical skills, advanced individual dexterity, ability to communicate and work in team, leadership abilities, knowledge of resource and crisis management.

In the UCSMT training is provided on the basis of curricula programs and extra-curricular courses organized in several modules:

- Programs for Medical Maneuvers and basic surgical techniques;
- Programs for Internal Medicine;
- Programs for Standard Patients and Communication;

- Programs for Surgery;
- Programs for Anesthesiology and Intensive Care;
- Programs for Emergency Medicine;
- Programs for Mother and Child;
- Programs for Endoscopy;
- Programs for Medical Imaging.

The Society in Europe for Simulation Applied to Medicine presents UCSMT as a model of a simulation center in its network.







What do you need to know?

How to apply

Students are enrolled twice per year: autumn batch (July-August) and spring batch (December-January).

In order to be admitted to the entrance contest, the applicants must submit by email (to: *foreign@usmf.md*) the following scanned documents:

- Application form;
- A copy of the foreigner's national passport valid not less than one year;
- year;

- A notarized copy of the birth certificate;
- A copy of the school leaving certificates: Baccalaureate Diploma or its equivalent, a legalized translation of it into Romanian, Russian or English language and with an apostille from Ministry of Justice (Education) from the applicant's country;
- Police certificate;
- Passport size photo.

After approving of all documents, the candidate has to pass an interview and an evaluation test. In order to enter the Republic of Moldova, citizens of some countries may require visa, which is issued in diplomatic missions of the Republic of Moldova abroad.

Entry requirements for the foreign candidates:

- B2 level for the teaching language
- completed secondary education
- at least 18 years old

Tuition fee

The tuition fee has to be paid in advance for the entire academic year

and remains unchanged throughout the period of studies.

The tuition fee covers: attendance of the courses (practical and theoretical), library entrance and use of the resources, use of the laboratories and the equipment during the academic year.

The tuition fee does not include the costs of accommodation, admission fee, registration and legalization of temporary residence in the Republic of Moldova.

Although it is a small country, Moldova as a destination has a lot to offer - beautiful places and landscapes, a rich history and traditions.

Chisinau is the capital of Moldova. It is the largest city of the country and its political, administrative, economical and cultural centre. The capital of Moldova is considered to be one of the greenest cities in Europe. There are many parks in the city and trees grow on almost every street.




and gentlemen. Also, the meals at the universi-
